

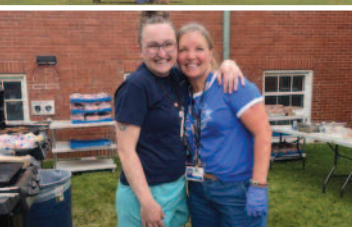


Dear community, friends, and valued donors,
