On behalf of my fellow trustees I am delighted to share with you some of the highlights of the Foundation's work over the past year.

We understand that investing in our local hospital is essential for the health and wellness of our community, and we are proud to showcase just some of the initiatives that were made possible with the help of your generous donations. With your continued support, we can advance these important projects and many more.



**Physician Recruitment and Retention** – A large part of our focus the last few years has been physician recruitment. To this end our recruitment team, led by Foundation Chairman **Dr. Al Doucet**, have successfully managed to secure **Dr. Allison Freeman**, **Dr. Asaad Abuelgasim**, **Dr. Alison Freeman**, **Dr. Andrew Bray**, **Dr. Folasade Akinwande**, **Dr. Natasha Harlow** and nurse practitioner **Ella Tweedie**.

**Queens General Hospital Beautification Project** – Our commitment to beautifying the Hospital property for the enjoyment of patients and family continues under the care of **Angela Roy** and her crew. This beautification has been very well received.

**Health Professional Suite** – The Foundation, recognizing a need to house medical professionals who travel to Queens General Hospital, finalized a Health Professional Suite on the third floor of Queens General. The suite has three ensuite rooms with a common living area and kitchenette. This and other initiatives, along with the support and cooperation of hospital medical staff, has resulted in Queens General being chosen by Dalhousie Medical School to be included in their residency program. This program places future medical professionals in our community with the hopes that they will want to return to rural medicine.

**Queens County Transit** – We have also continued our partnership with Queens County Transit (QCT). Our funding contribution to QCT is used to subsidize Queens County residents who require medical transport and are financially disadvantaged.

**SSRH MRI** – This year also saw QGHF pay the final installment of our commitment to the MRI diagnostic machine being installed in South Shore Regional Hospital in Bridgewater as part of their redevelopment plan. Our support of this project will ensure enhanced and prompt diagnosis for Queens County residents.
